a. Phase 1: Online Learning (2 Weeks)

Engage in a comprehensive series of online learning that lay the groundwork for your understanding of Indonesia's language, culture, and society. Connect with peers and instructors virtually, building a foundation for the in-person phase.

Complete all provided courses, and the top 10 participants will receive the opportunity for an in-person learning experience directly in Indonesia.

b. Phase 2: In-Person Experience (2 Weeks)

a. Orientation in Jakarta

Begin your Indonesian adventure with an orientation in Jakarta, the bustling capital city of Indonesia. During your 4 days, you will be staying

at the head office and main campus of Universitas Terbuka to familiarize yourself with Indonesia and also prepare yourself for the upcoming field visit.

b. Field Visit in Bali

Continue your journey to Bali, renowned for its cultural heritage and scenic beauty. Participate in traditional ceremonies, visit historical sites, and immerse yourself in local arts and crafts.

During the time in Bali, international students will be accompanied by local counterparts, who are UT students from Bali, to ensure the most immersive learning experience.

- Students will be able to function in real world multicultural situations effectively.
- Students will be able to nurture global citizenship comprehensively.
