

2026 Sias University Global Youth Camp

1. Program overview

(1) Program period: Oct 26th- Oct 31st, 2026

(Suggested arrival date: Oct 25th, suggested departure date: Nov 1st)

(2) Activities include: Peer dialogue, Cultural excursions, Lectures on Chinese history, language, culture, International Culture Week activities...

2. Pick-up Service

(1) Pick-up service is available for all participants at Zhengzhou Xingzheng International Airport (CGO) on October 25th, from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Participants who arrive outside these hours should arrange their own transportation to the Sias campus.

(2) To reserve your pick-up, please email your flight/train details to 19323@sias.edu.cn or 21311@sias.edu.cn as soon as your tickets are confirmed. (Submission deadline: Oct 18th)

(3) Upon arrival at the airport, look for our staff holding a "Sias University" sign at the exit.



3. Scholarship slots

Sias University offers 2 complimentary slots for each partner school, which covers:

- Program fees
- Airport pickup and local transportation
- On-campus accommodation

Additional slots (once scholarships are filled) are available at a self-pay rate:

- Partner university students: 198USD/person
- Non-partner university students: 298USD/person

4. Accommodation

(1) Sias University provides free accommodation (shared room) from the night of Oct 25th through the night of Oct 31st.

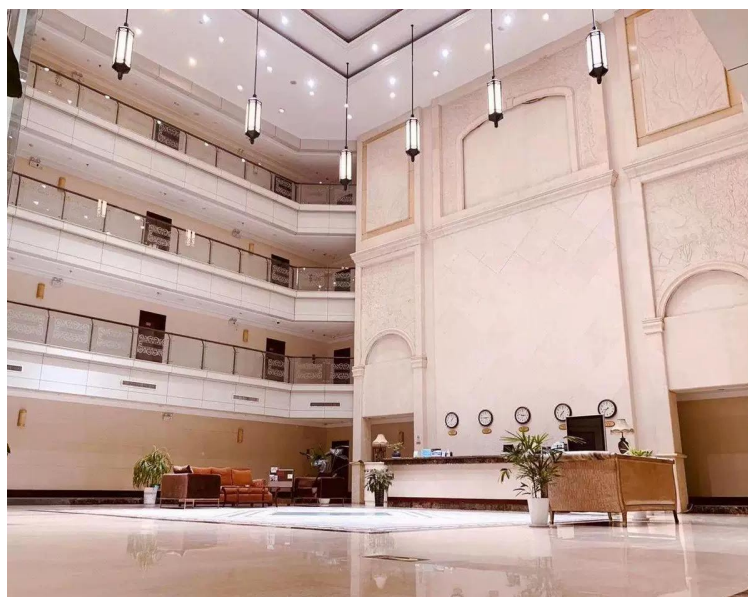
(2) Room Upgrade: If a participant requests a single room, the cost is 25USD per night.

(3) For participants arriving early or departing late, accommodation fees will be self-paid at a rate of 25USD per day.

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5. Food cost and options

On-campus meal costs range from 6USD to 20USD per day.



6. Payments

(1) The most commonly used and convenient mobile payment methods in China include Alipay and WeChat Pay, all accessible via smartphone.

(2) Cash Usage Tips:

- Exchange a small amount of RMB (suggested: 1,000–2,000 RMB) at your local bank or upon arrival at the airport for initial expenses.
- Keep cash distributed between bags or pockets and avoid displaying large amounts in public.

7. Optional post-camp culture trip to Beijing and Shanghai (November 1st – 6th):

- The cost for the optional culture trip is 798USD per person. Payments in cash (RMB or USD), Alipay, or WeChat Pay are accepted upon arrival at Sias University. Inter-city train tickets are not included. (Train ticket price reference: Zhengzhou – Beijing 52USD, Beijing – Shanghai 95USD)
- The culture trip concludes in Shanghai on Nov 6th, allowing participants to depart directly from Shanghai.

8. Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Which visa should I apply for?

A: An L (Tourist) Visa.

Q: If I arrive earlier or later than the scheduled date, will pick-up service be available?

A: No. Pick-up is provided only on October 25th between 8:00 AM and 8:00 PM.

Q: Does the program offer any financial assistance for flight tickets?

A: No. All airfare costs are entirely at the participant's own expense.

Q: I registered through the Google link, but I haven't received any feedback yet.

A: Our team will send confirmation emails after September 13th. If you still have not received a response by then, please contact us.
